

White Wines

Fiddlers Green Waipara Sauvignon Blanc	\$12.50	\$40.00
Grown in the micro-climate of North Canterbury's Waipara region this wine displays the more tropical and herbaceous characters of the sauvignon blanc grape variety with a crisp, intense palate and structure.		
Main Divide Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc	\$12.50	\$40.00
Made from grapes grown in the Wairau Valley Marlborough this fresh clean wine displays characters of passionfruit, citrus and gooseberries and underlying herbal complexities.		
Mudhouse Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc		\$45.00
Displays aromas of guava, passionfruit and gooseberry with underlying herbaceous hints and a long lingering finish.		
Allan Scott Marlborough Pinot Gris	\$12.50	\$40.00
A complex wine with aromas of red apple, pear and white stonefruit. The long soft mid palate gives way to a balanced structure of acid and phenolics, creating good endurance, elevated by the sweet warmth of the alcohol.		
Oyster Bay Marlborough Chardonnay	\$14.00	\$45.00
A Marlborough chardonnay with concentrated aromas and flavours of ripe citrus and stonefruit, balanced with subtle oak and a creamy texture finish.		
Muddy Water Chardonnay		\$54.00
Grown and handcrafted in the Waipara region this chardonnay has been barrel fermented for 11 months to produce a balanced mineral wine with buttery peach -like fruit flavours with a subtle lingering finish.		
Weka River Riesling	\$14.00	\$45.00
Grown in the Waipara region this off-dry Riesling has been picked over three weeks to ensure the fullest ripening and with some botrytis influence. The wine exhibits classic Waipara flavours of ginger, cinnamon and orange zest with a palate of grapefruit and white pepper.		
Main Divide Pokiri Late Picked Pinot Gris	\$13.50	\$44.00
The wine emanates a ripe fruit bouquet, suggestive of pears, yellow-fleshed peaches and fresh raw figs. These same flavours flow through into the palate where the wine has impressive fruit concentration and depth. A steely backbone complements its off-dry finish and provides a tingling minerality which helps draw out the lingering after-taste.

Allan Scott Marlborough Late Harvest Sauvignon Blanc		\$42.00
A complex array of ripe stone fruits . The palate is long and luscious with nectarines, white peach, and apricot. It has a good focal point constructed by the acid and phenolic compounds giving a lengthy finish.

Angus The Bull Cabernet Sauvignon	\$12.50	\$40.00
Blended from grapes collected from South Australia and Victoria this full bodied wine, inky black in colour with concentrated ripe fruits and a savoury oak finish.		
Mudhouse Merlot	\$13.50	\$44.00
Aromas of dark spiced plum, black olive and truffle with dark cherry and plum flavours with supple tannins and toasty oak on a warm lingering palate.		
Main Divide Pinot Noir	\$13.50	\$44.00
Displaying fine velvety tannins with rich ripe fruit flavours while retaining a fresh vibrancy. Aged in French oak for 12 months.		
Carrick Unravelled Pinot Noir		\$45.00
Grown and bottled in Central Otago just outside of Bannockburn this pinot noir displays flavours of cherries, a touch of wild thyme and soft oak with a lasting finish.		
The Wooing Tree Beetlejuice Pinot Noir		\$45.00
Ripe hand picked fruit, gentle winemaking and maturation in French oak, 35% new, have resulted in a very approachable and rich wine, with aromas of ripe cherries, raspberries and Black Doris plums, a rich and silky smooth palate with fine grainy tannins to match the fruit.		
Barossa Valley Estate E Minor Shiraz	\$14.00	\$45.00
Grown in one of Australia's most renowned shiraz growing regions, this wine displays aromas of dark fruit and cherries with subtle oak and a palate of firm acidity with gentle oak and spicy dark fruits and a lingering finish.		
Grant Burge Barossa Miamba Shiraz		\$52.00
The intense aromas of dark chocolate coated licorice, sweet confectionary coconut ice, dark flesh fruits like plums and black cherries are only enhanced by cedar like aromas and a hint of mint. The palate is equally generous with a palate of rich fruit flavours, melded together with the acidity and tannins which equate to a well balanced wine		
Esk Valley Merlot Cabernet Sauvignon Malbec		\$48.00
This complex blend was grown in the Gimblett Gravels vineyards of Hawkes Bay. A blend of 39% Merlot, 37% Cabernet Sauvignon and 24% Malbec, aged in oak barriques for 12 months and displays characters of cherry, plum, chocolate and dried herbs.
