Fresh fruit characters with underlying hints of tropical fruit and subtle herbaceous aromas with a mouthful of grapefruit and mandarin flavours with a zingy citrus finish.		
Fiddlers Green Waipara Sauvignon Blanc	\$7.50	\$35.00
Grown in the micro-climate of North Canterbury's Waipara region this wine displays the more tropical and herbaceous characters of the Sauvignon Blanc variety wine with a crisp, intense palate and structure.		
Main Divide Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc	\$7.50	\$35.00
Made from grapes grown in the Wairau Valley Marlborough this fresh clean wine displays characters of passionfruit, citrus and gooseberries and underlying herbal complexities.		
Mudhouse Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc	\$8.00	\$40.00
Displays aromas of guava, passionfruit and gooseberry with underlying herbaceous hints and a long lingering finish.		
Oyster Bay Marlborough Chardonnay	\$7.50	\$35.00
A Marlborough chardonnay with concentrated aromas and flavours of ripe citrus and stonefruit, balanced with subtle oak and a creamy texture finish.		
Main Divide Riesling	\$8.00	\$40.00
A Canterbury grown Riesling with fresh fruity characters and vibrant aromas. An off-dry style Riesling with plenty of acidity and a clean finish.		
Mt Difficulty Pinot Gris	\$8.50	\$45.00
The wine displays aromas of white peach blossom mingled with Bon Chretien pear. The palate reveals luscious fruit in the same vein while the mid palate is full, creamy and well textured. The wine has a rich mineral, stonefruit driven finish.

Delegats Hawkes Bay Merlot Cabernet	\$7.00	\$30.00
The cabernet sauvignon provides rounded, full bodied berry flavours while the merlot imparts soft fruit characters. Aged in small oak barrels.		
Angus The Bull Cabernet Sauvignon	\$7.50	\$35.00
Blended from grapes collected from South Australia and Victoria this full bodied wine, inky black in colour with concentrated ripe fruits and a savoury oak finish.		
Mudhouse Merlot	\$8.00	\$38.00
Aromas of dark spiced plum, black olive and truffle with dark cherry and plum flavours with supple tannins and toasty oak on a warm lingering palate.		
Main Divide Pinot Noir	\$8.50	\$40.00
Displaying fine velvety tannins with rich ripe fruit flavours while retaining a fresh vibrancy. Aged in French oak for 12 months.		
Carrick Unravalled Pinot Noir	\$9.00	\$42.00
Grown and bottled in Central Otago just outside of Bannockburn this pinot noir displays flavours of cherries, a touch of wild thyme and soft oak with a lasting finish.		
St Hallett Faith Barossa Shiraz	\$9.50	\$45.00
Grapes grown in one of Australia's most renowned shiraz growing regions, this wine displays rich cherry and blackberry flavours with supple tannins and a silky lingering finish.		
Esk Valley Merlot Cabernet Sauvignon Malbec	\$11.50	\$55.00
This complex blend was grown in the Gimblett Gravels vineyards of Hawkes Bay. A blend of 39% Merlot, 37% Cabernet Sauvignon and 24% Malbec, aged in oak barriques for 12 months and displays characters of cherry, plum, chocolate and dried herbs.
